SPECIAL NOTES FOR PARENTS

- a. Parents of Vegetarians should inform camp director before booking their child into camp, entry pending meal option availability.
- b. Camp drop off is on Sunday from 4:00 – 5:00 pm – please do not arrive early as we are taking care of camp turnover.
- c. Pickup times are Saturdays at 11:00 am (no show) or 9:00 am for Show Camp (10 am start of show, usually ending around 1-2 pm)
- d. For all shows, bring lawnchairs, shade & a snack for yourselves and your camper. ***No sandals or pets please.*
- e. For parents bringing a friend to camp, please contact us and we will email a waiver form to be signed by the parent & brought to camp.
- f. Payment methods - INTERAC TRANSFER, CHEQUE by mail, or CREDIT CARD over the phone. Final Payment at camp - CASH or DEBIT
- g. If your child is a picky eater, OR has any social issues or disabilities, you must discuss with the camp director BEFORE booking into camp.

NOTE: by signing this form, you are agreeing that you fully understand and will abide by the following camp policies:

- 1. By signing this form the parent/guardian is giving the camp staff the right to obtain medical attention necessary for the camper's welfare and good health during their stay. The parent/guardian is responsible for all associated costs.
- 2. This form gives permission for the child to participate in the entire program.
- 3. All prices and taxes are in Canadian funds and are per child, and are subject to 13% hst tax.
- 4. Each camper must be covered by Ontario Health Insurance or USA equivalent and the number supplied on this form.
- 5. The parent/guardian certifies that the camper is in good health & mental condition and is amenable to camp life, eats well, and communicates well.
- 6. For withdrawal before or during camp (and only by order of a physician) there will be no refunds – the camp director may offer future considerations depending on the situation and the amount of cancellation time – we do our best to come to a good resolution.
- 7. Parents requiring airport pick-up understand there are fees, and will contact the Camp Director to organize this event.
- 8. ALL Parents will be required to sign the company's release of liability waiver form – email for a copy if you are sending your child with a friend
- 9. By joining camp, you give Highland Wilderness Tours the right to photograph or video your child & use these items for promotional material & positive statements about Highland Wilderness Tours may be used for publicizing the program. Full names will NOT be used in this process.
- 10. The Camp lists and all pertinent camp information are available online at www.ridethewilderness.com/expedition.htm
- 11. The NON-REFUNDABLE camp fee of HALF is due when the camp is booked, with a payment schedule for those wishing payments (attached)
- 12. This form MUST be supplied at the time of booking. Email or snailmail the form to c/o Penny Nicol, Box 211 Maynooth Ontario K0L 2S0
- 13. Highland Wilderness Tours reserves the right to dismiss any camper who jeopardizes (through their actions or behaviour) the welfare of other campers or the ability for Highland Wilderness Tours to fulfill the itinerary of the camp safely and effectively. Such campers may be dismissed with no reimbursement of fees at the discretion of the Camp Director.
- 14. The following are NOT allowed at camp – cell phones, hair straighteners, excessive makeup, drugs, alcohol, or cigarettes.
- 15. Parents will notify the camp director if there are restrictions with regards to diet, movies, or soda beverages.
- 16. Camp starts promptly @ Sunday at 6:00 pm every week unless otherwise noted – *please do not arrive earlier than 4:00 PM as we are not available.*
